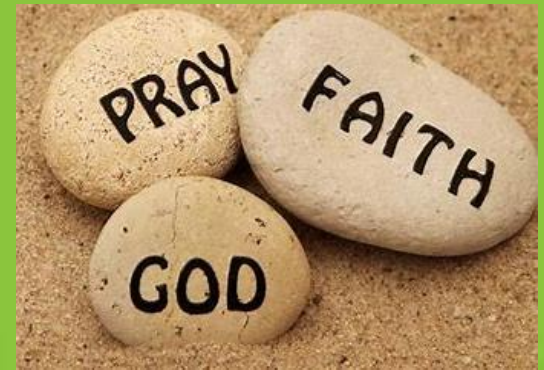

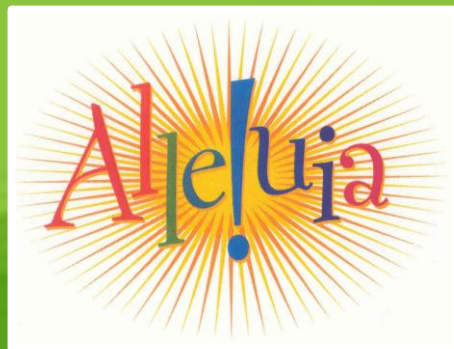

Generous God, help us to use our gifts and talents for good. They come from you to us to help make our earth a better place to live in.



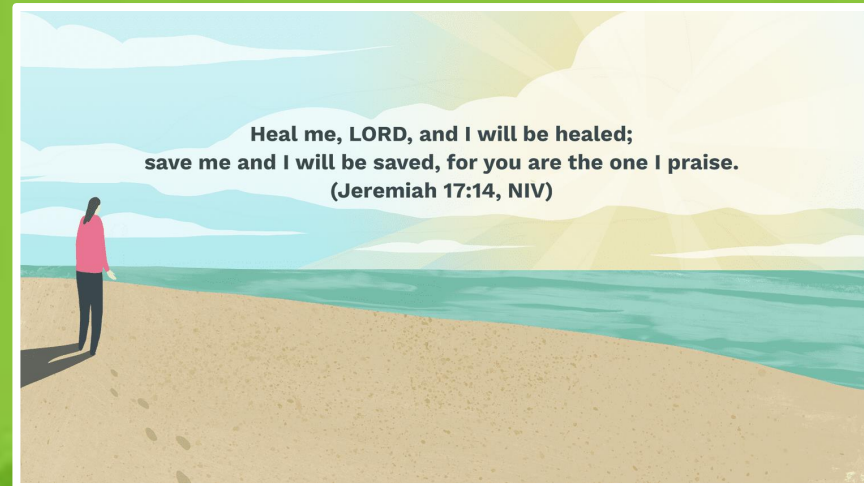
Generous God we pray for ourselves in this Jubilee Year that we will speak kind words and do kind actions.

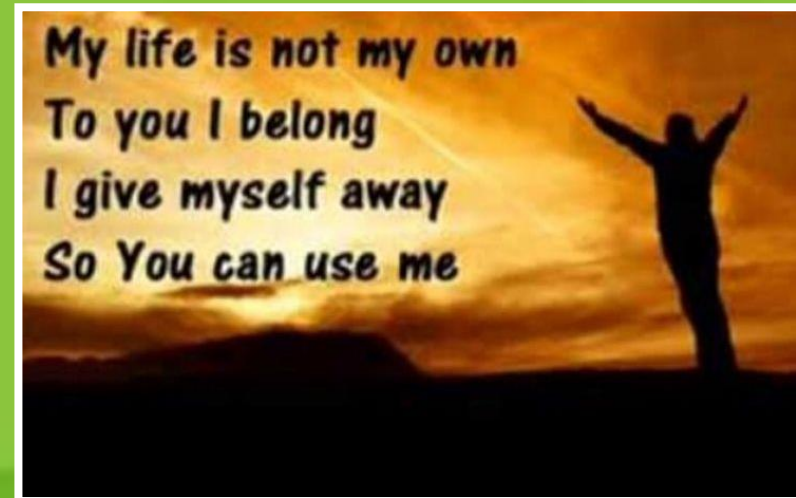
