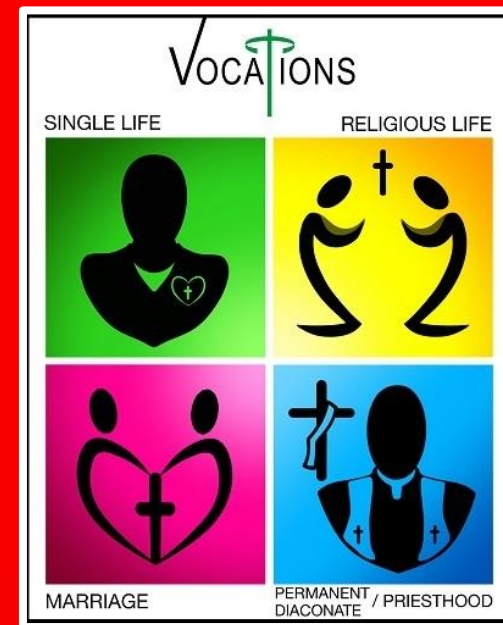

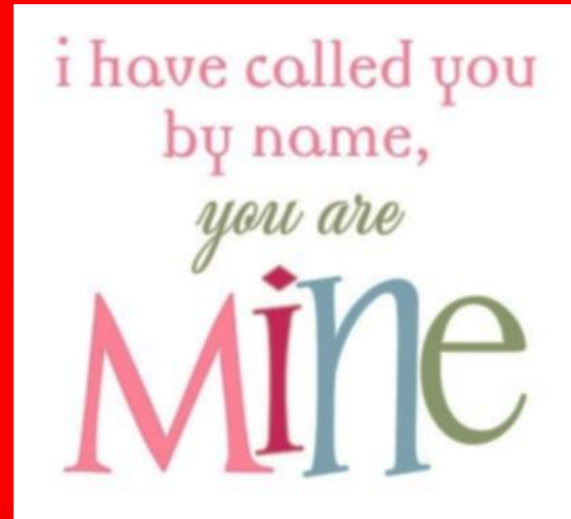

Christ our purpose, Christ our way.*

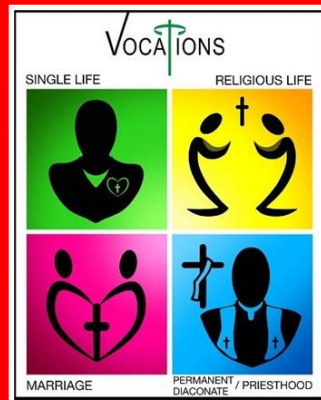


WELCOME

- Try to understand God's holy word



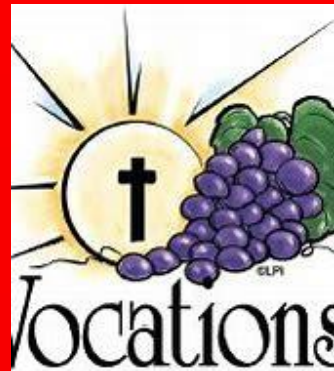
DISCERNING

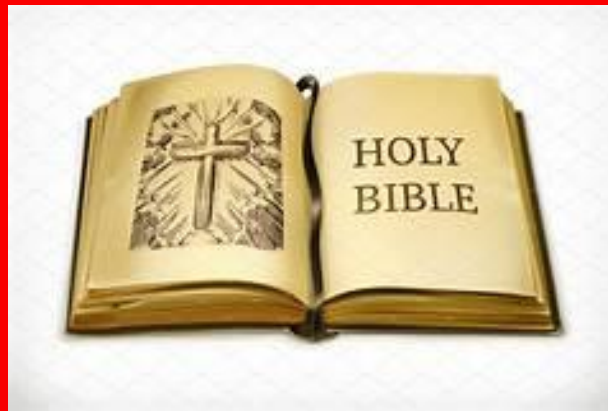
Heavenly Father we pray for Pope Francis that God will heal him. May we listen to his teachings, follow his path and have the courage to live our vocation.

Come and listen to me.



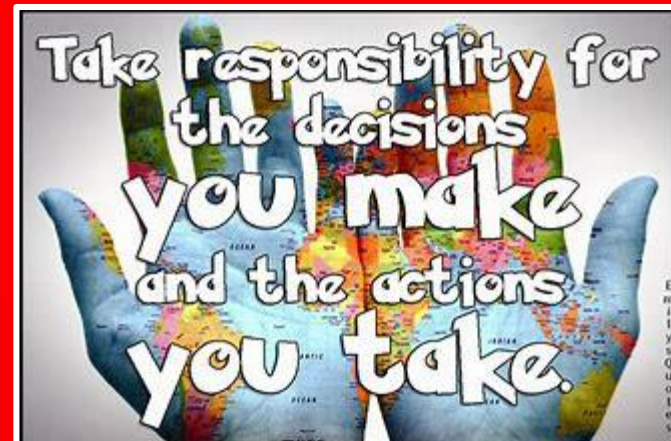

Come and listen to me.



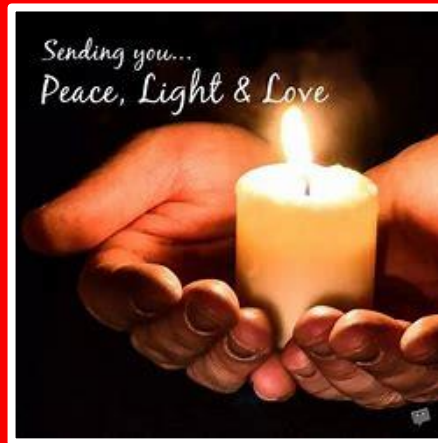
Heavenly Father, we pray for people who have no homes of food and no money to help themselves. May they get a roof over their head and a bed to sleep on.
