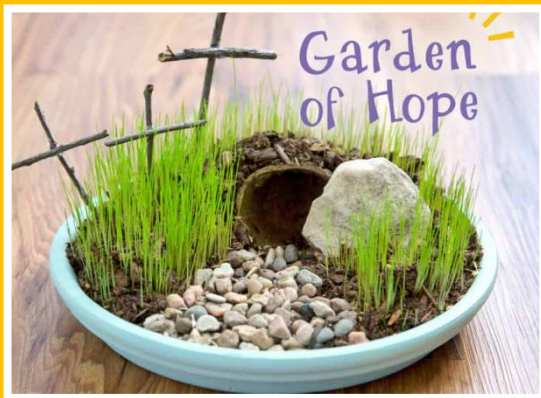
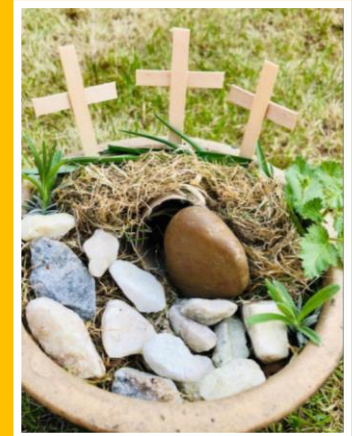

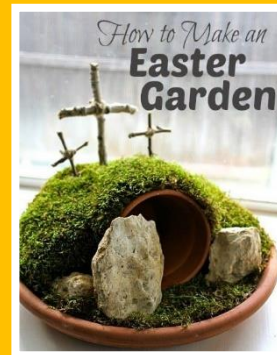
# The Easter Season

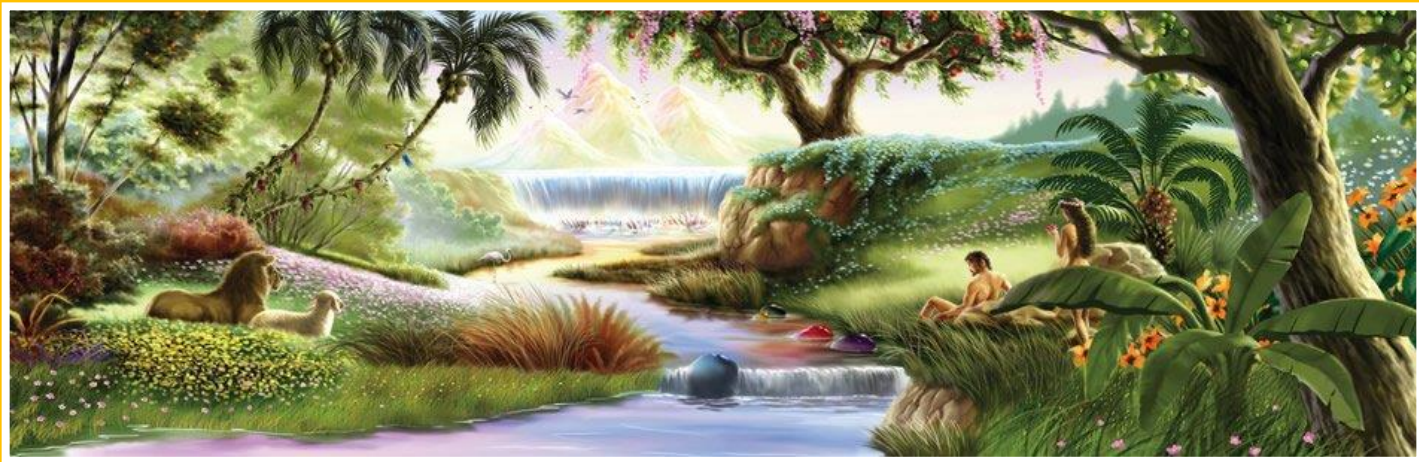
## Gardens in the Bible

3. The Garden that held the tomb of Jesus.

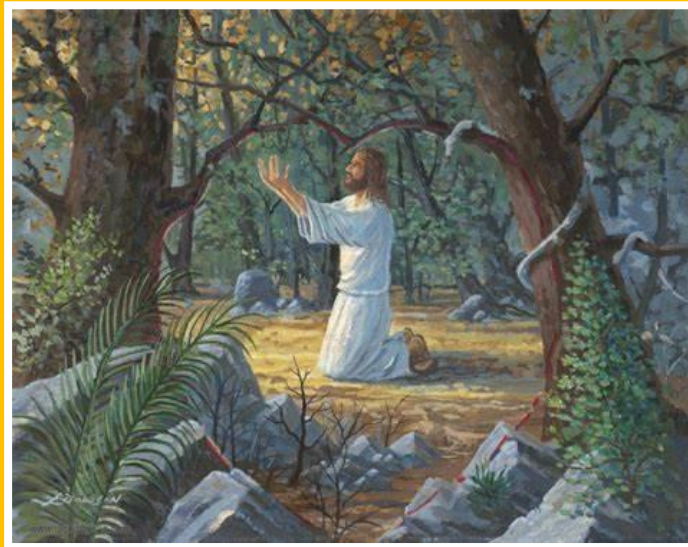
# Garden of Eden
