

this is my Body, given for you.


Do this in memory of me, take it and eat it,

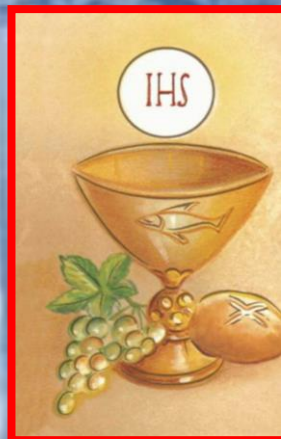




COMMUNION REFLECTION

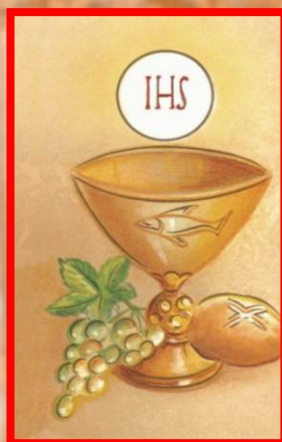
Loving Jesus, we thank you for our parents who have taken us to Church to be baptised so we can now receive Jesus in Holy Communion.

Wholesome Bread most pure feast, have mercy on us.


