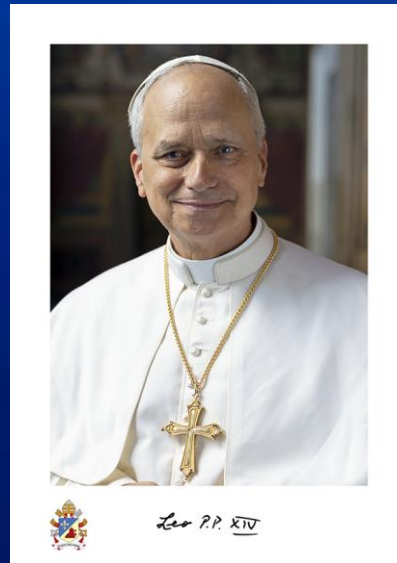


Ways we can be Curious and Active

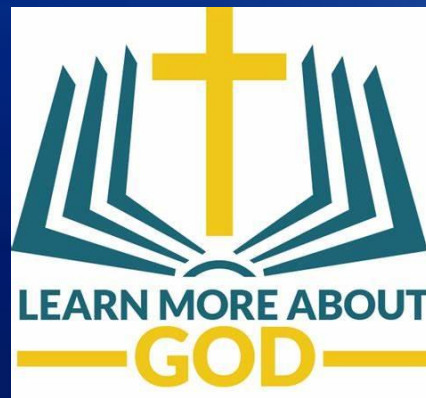
