to shine for you.

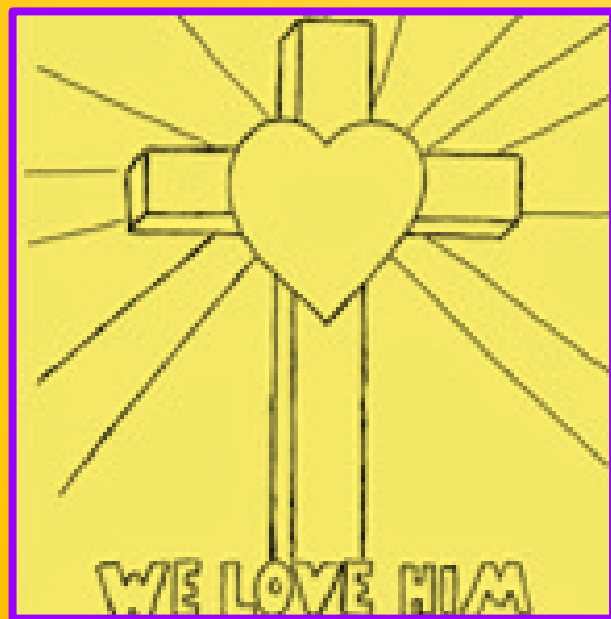


Jesus you can use my voice

Jesus I will shine for you.

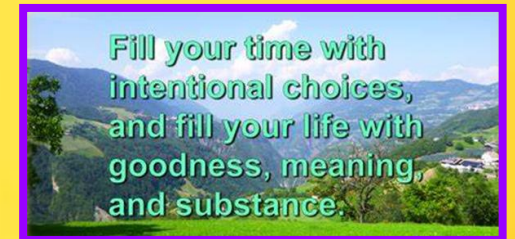

Prophetic

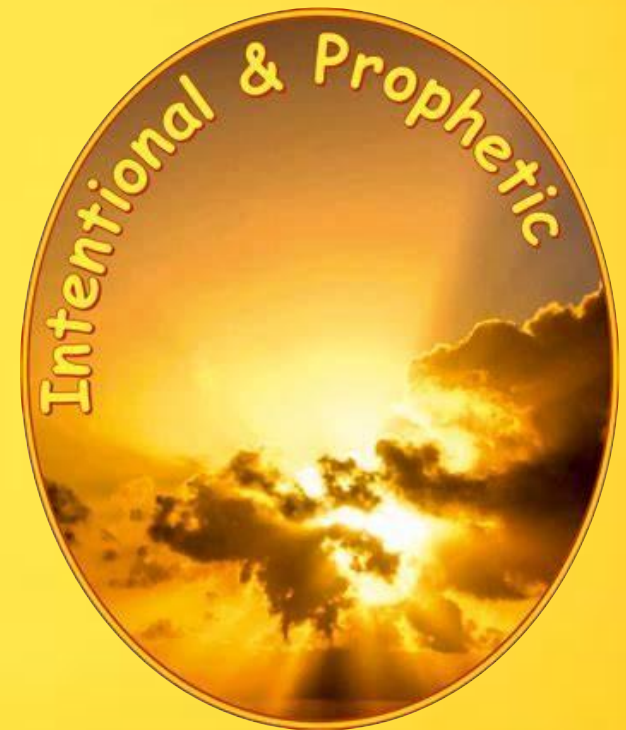
Spreading the word of God
