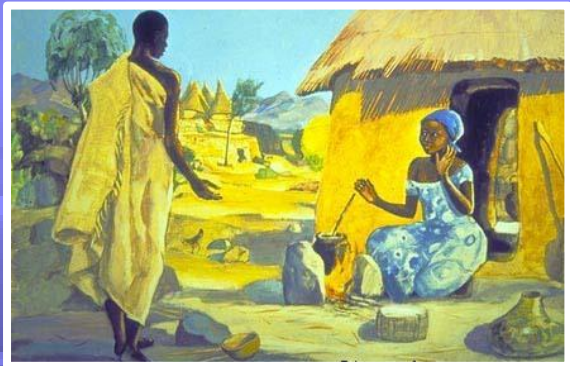

according to your Word.*

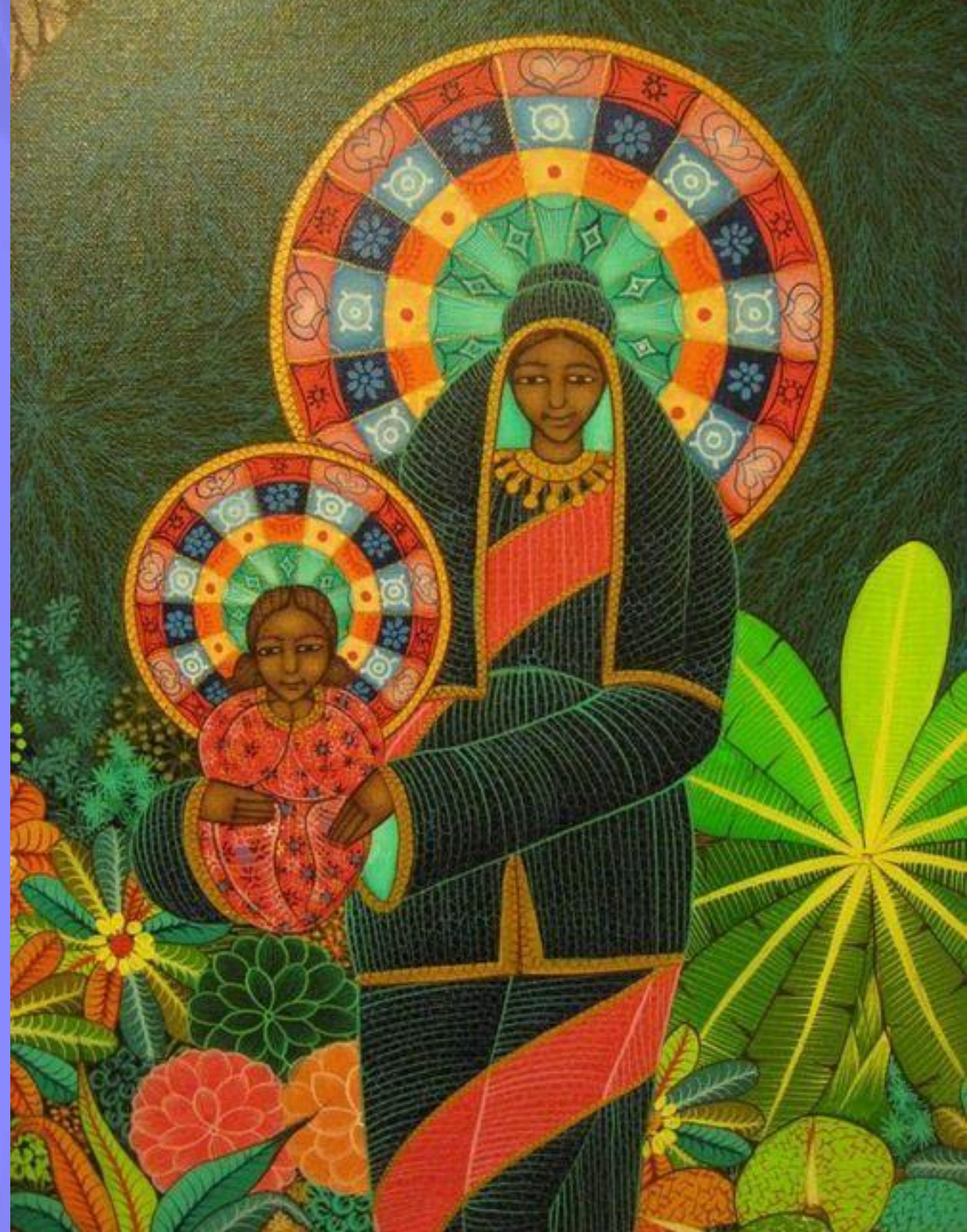


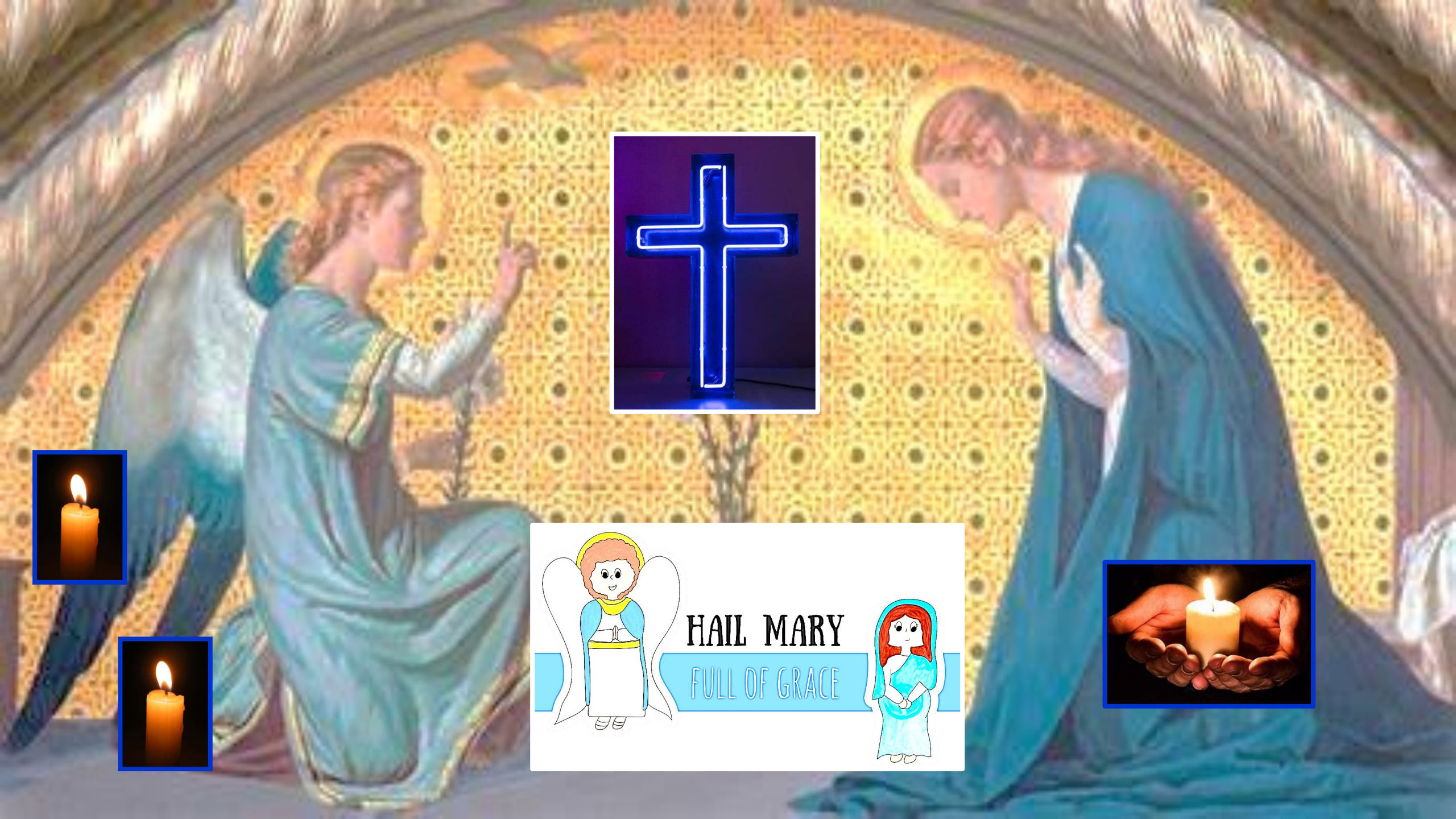

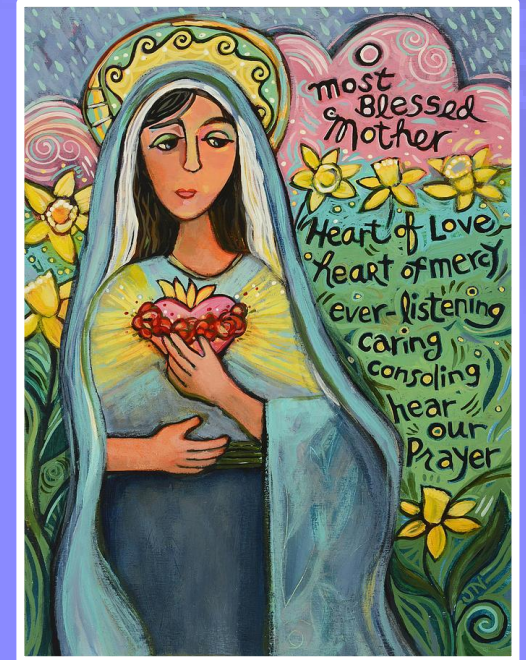

Ave, ave, ave, Maria.



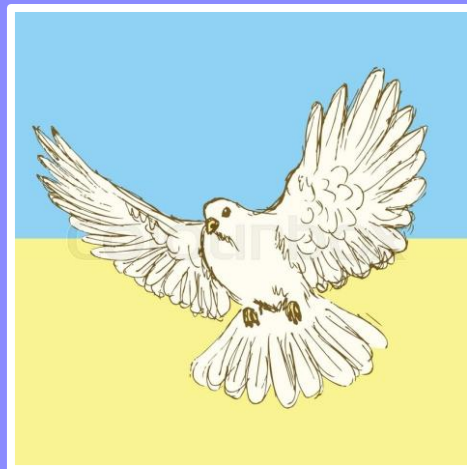
Loving Father, we pray that we will say Yes to you in all we do like Mary our Mother did.

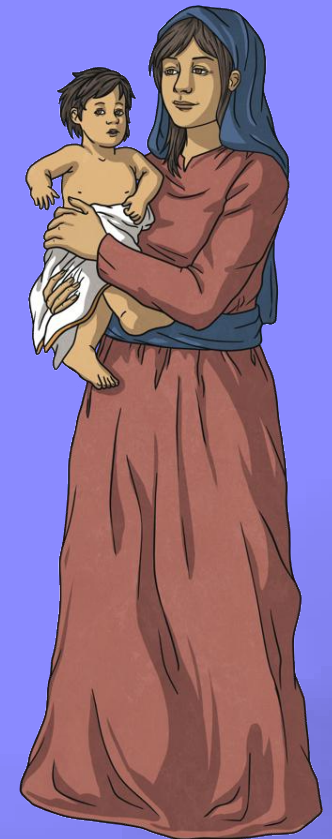
Loving Father, we pray for peace in our world so that nobody gets harmed and people can live in safety.

Final Prayer

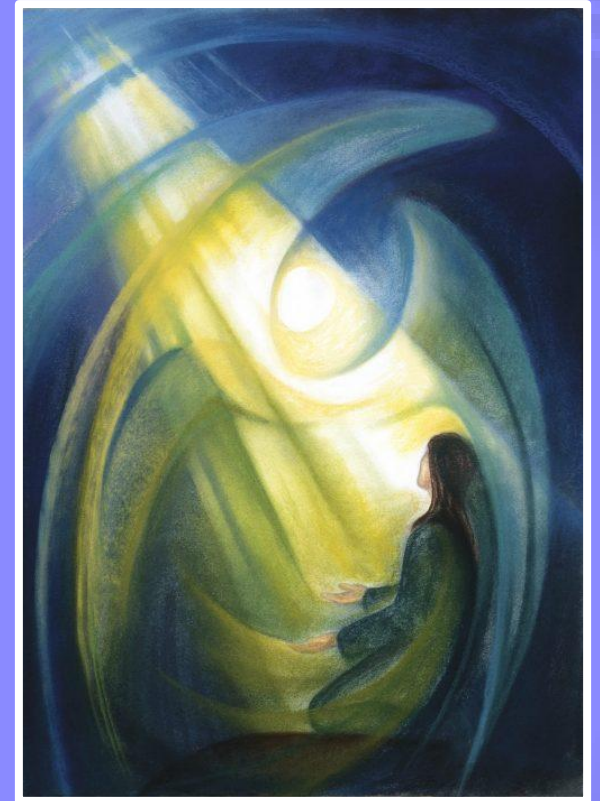
Mary was always faithful to God's will.
