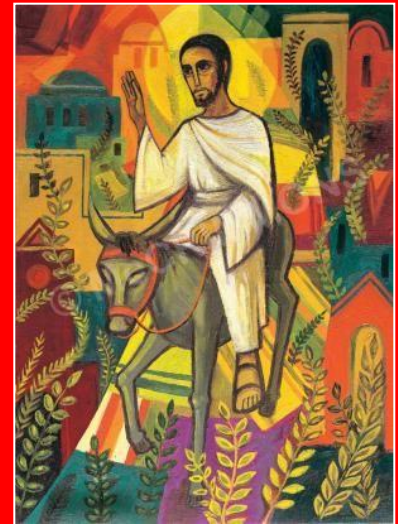

God bless the King of Israel.

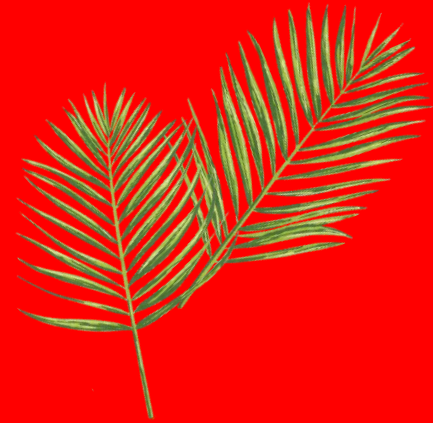
