says the Lord.


Anyone who eats this bread

A reading from the first letter of St Paul to the Corinthians

Dear friends, at the Last Supper before he died, the Lord Jesus took some bread, gave thanks to God, broke it and he said,

“This is my body, this is my gift to you, do this in memory of me.”



On the night before He died,
He took the bread in His holy hands;
blessed the bread and broke it
and gave it to His friends, and He said:

*Do this in memory of me,
this is my Body, given for you.*

*Do this in memory of me, take it and eat it,
remember me: remember me.*




In the same way he took the cup and said,

Lord Jesus, you are the Bread of Life for us.



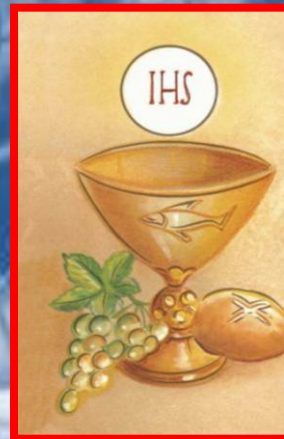
Loving Jesus, we pray for the children in Year 3 who are making their First Holy Communion that they will do well and get closer to you.

Final Hymn

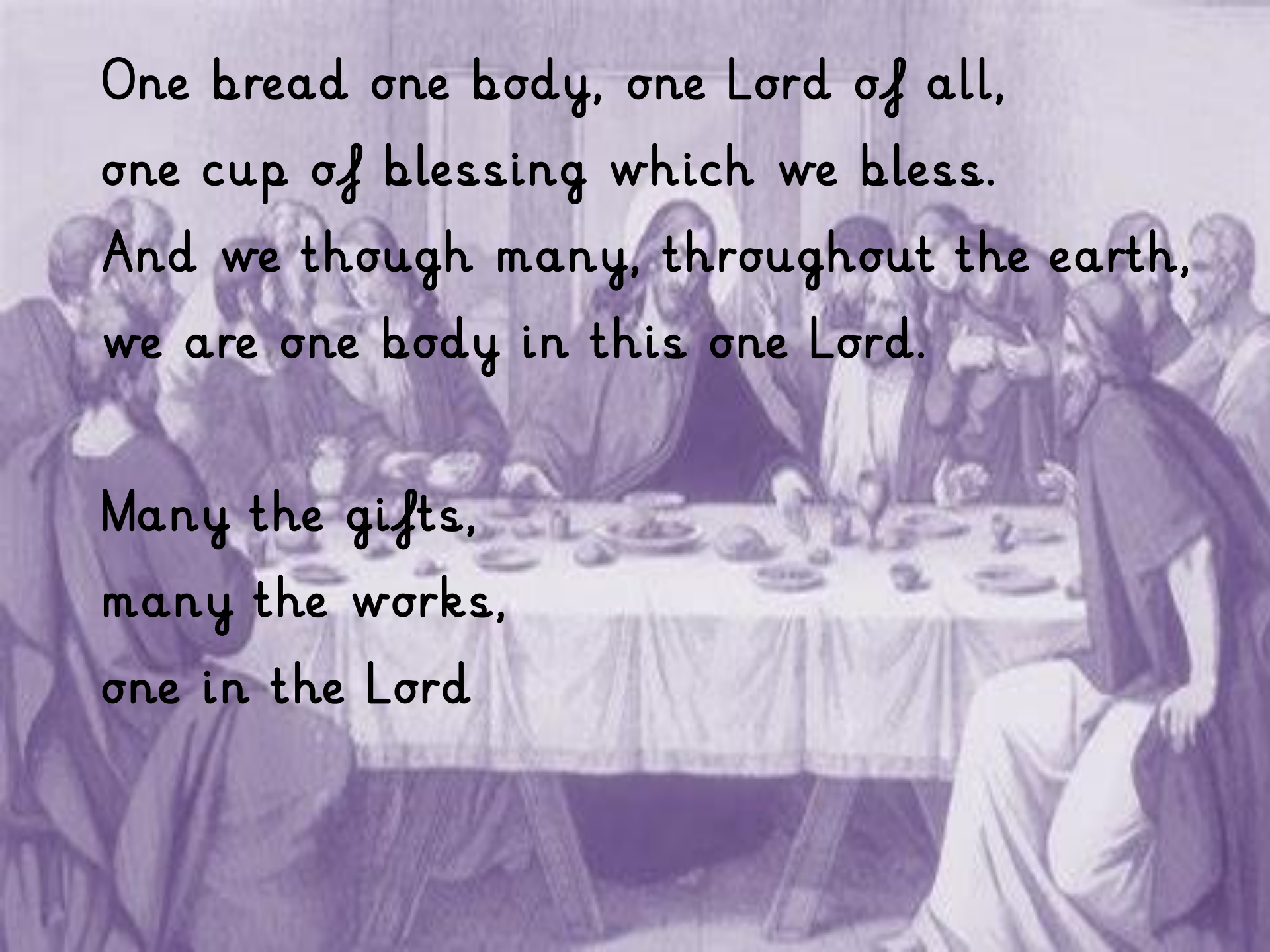

woman or man, no more.

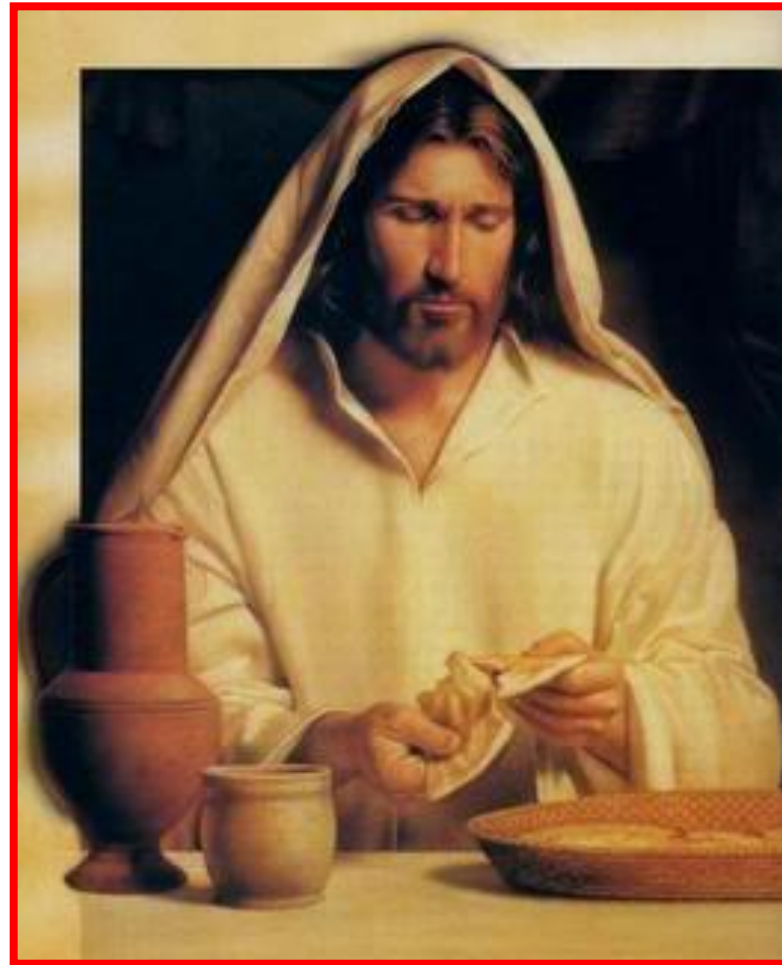
