In the 11th century people started to pray to the Sacred Heart and it was first celebrated in public in August 1675 in France. Around that time Margaret Mary, a French woman had visions of the Sacred Heart. Jesus showed her his heart when she was praying. He told her the flames around his heart showed how much He loves everyone.

The crown of thorns showed that He died for us because He loves us so much. We place the cross on top of the Sacred Heart because it reminds us of Jesus' death and resurrection.

In one of her visions Jesus asked Margaret Mary to request that the feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated every year 19 days after Pentecost.

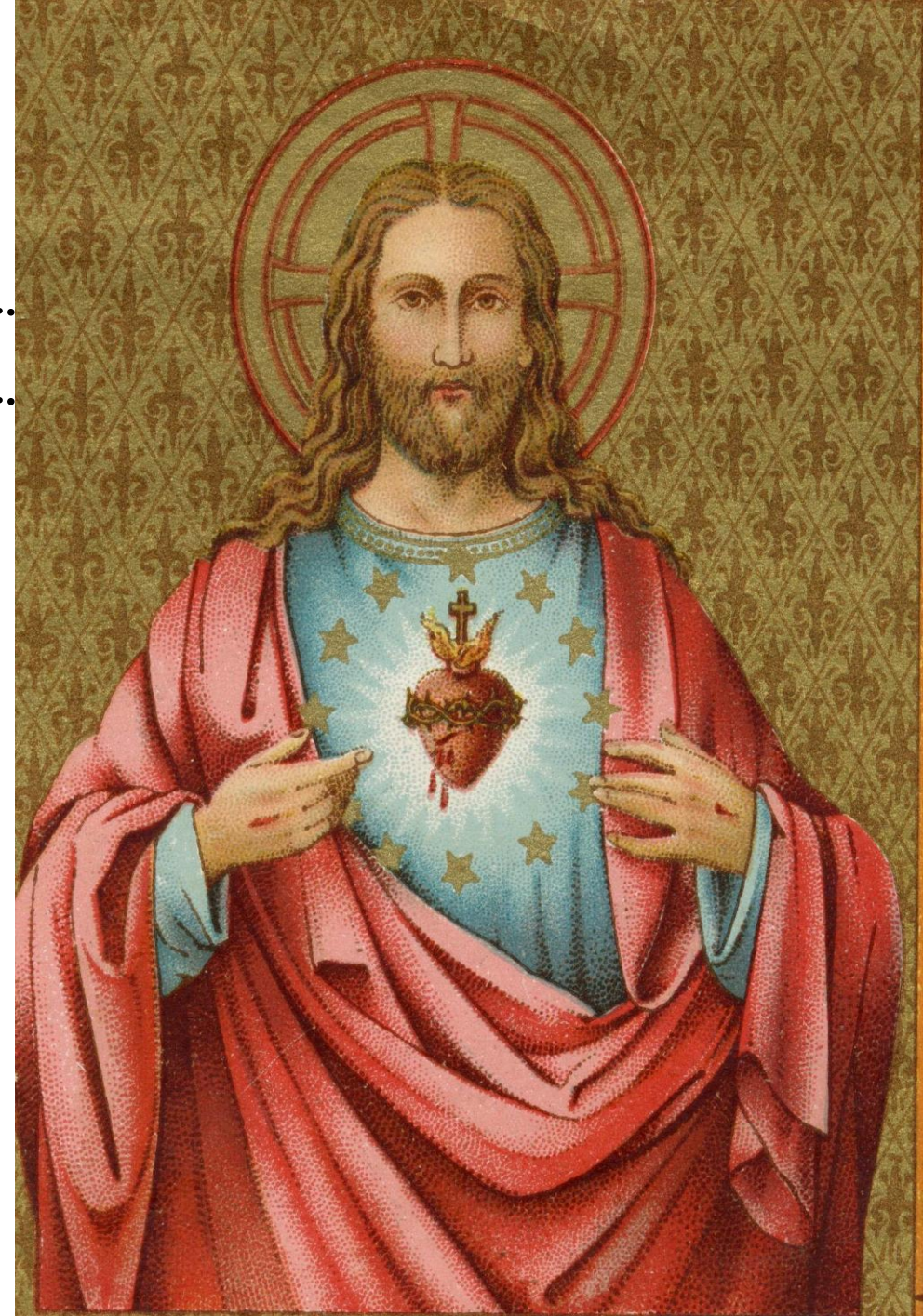

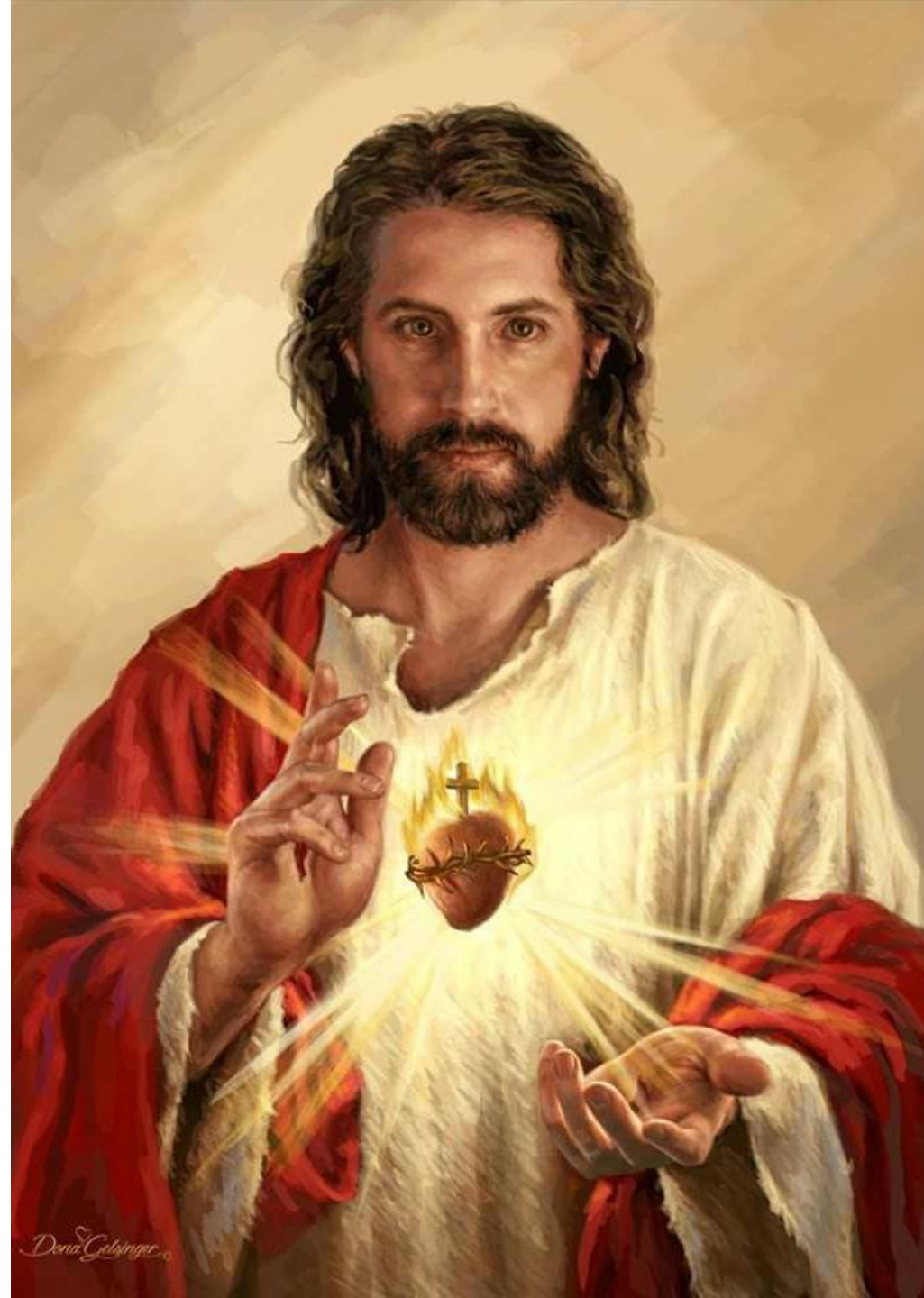

I place all my trust in you.



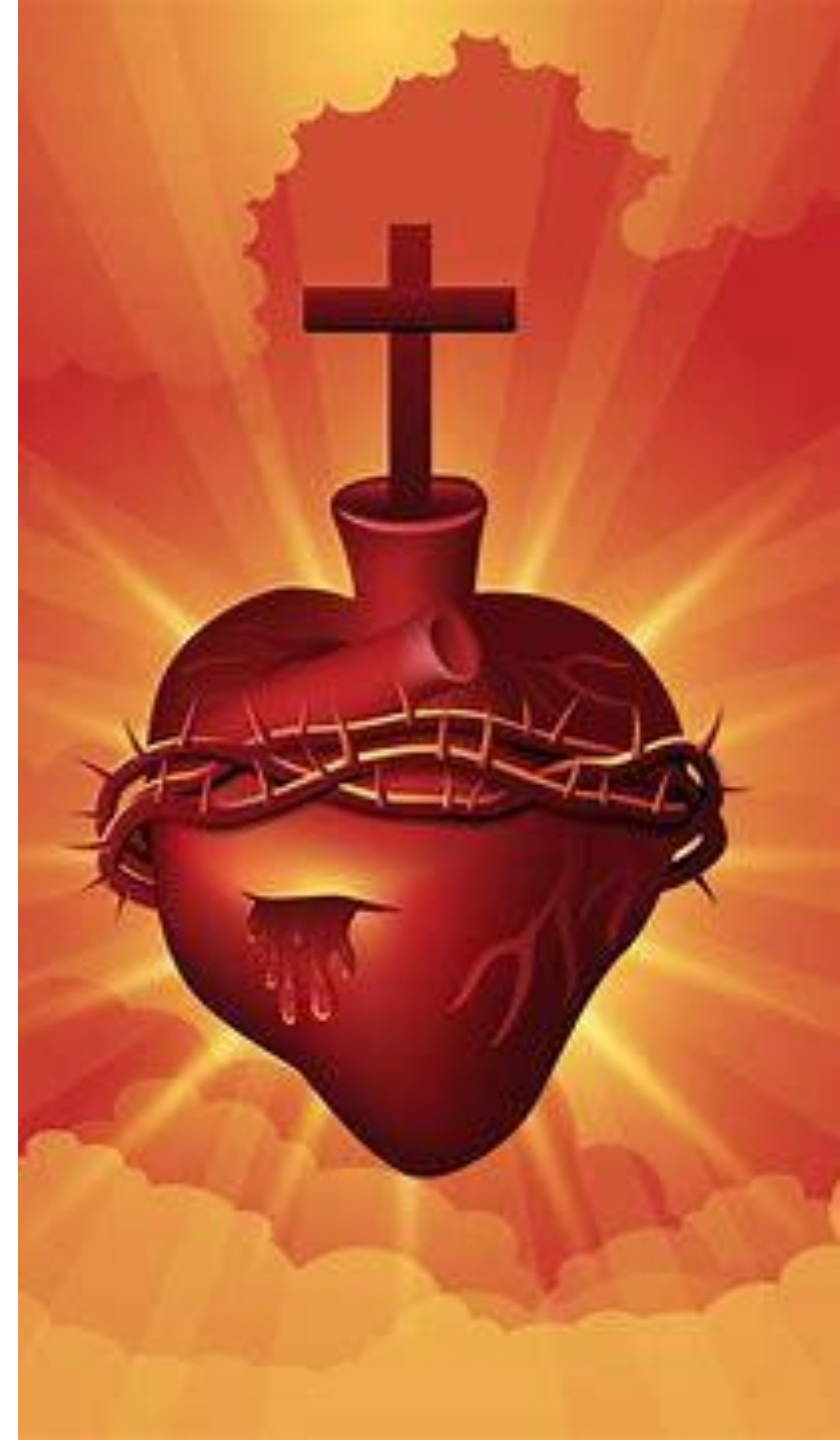


Loving Jesus, we pray for people waiting for surgery and people who are in hospital that they will be loved well. Please wrap your loving arms around them.

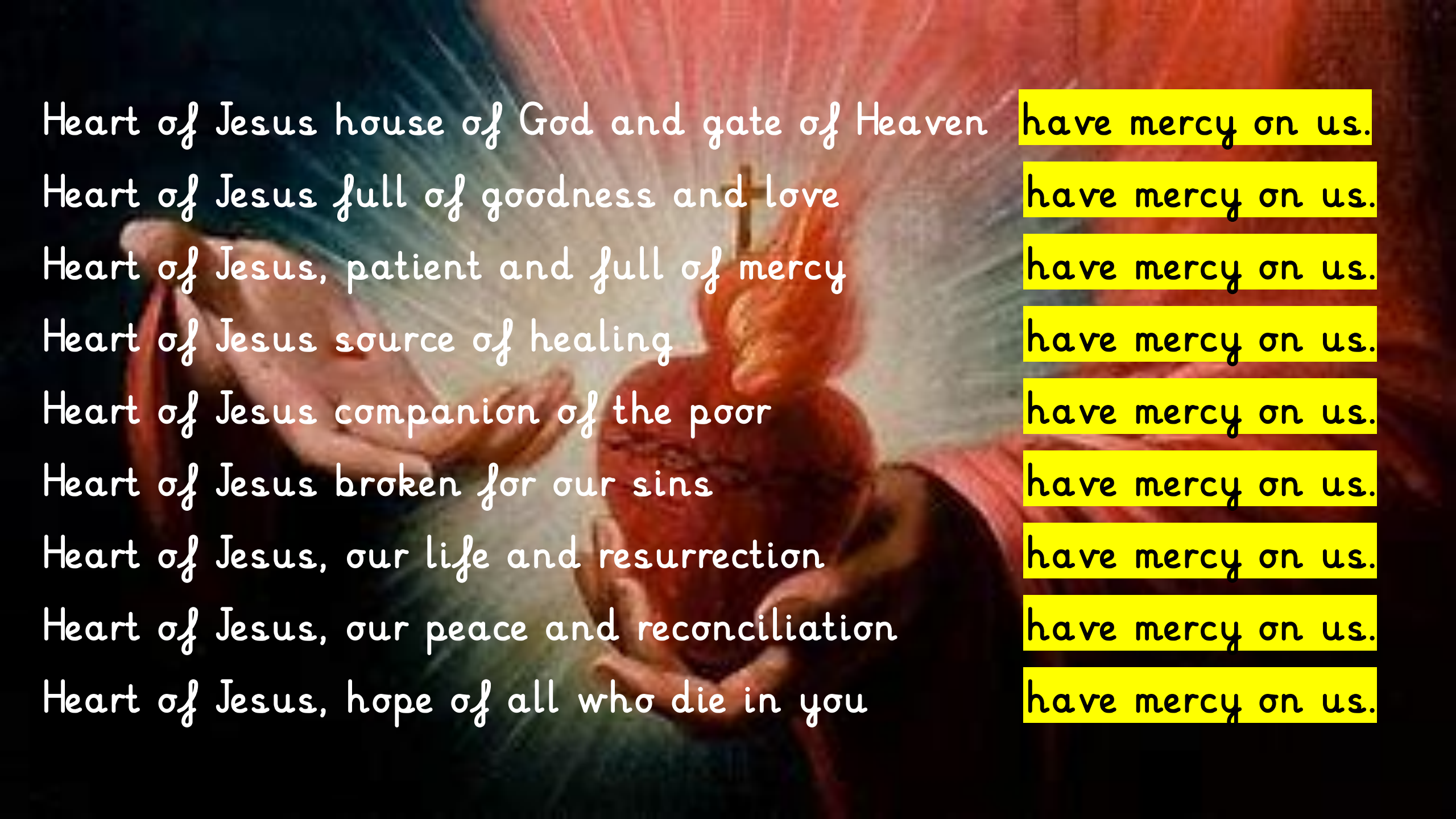

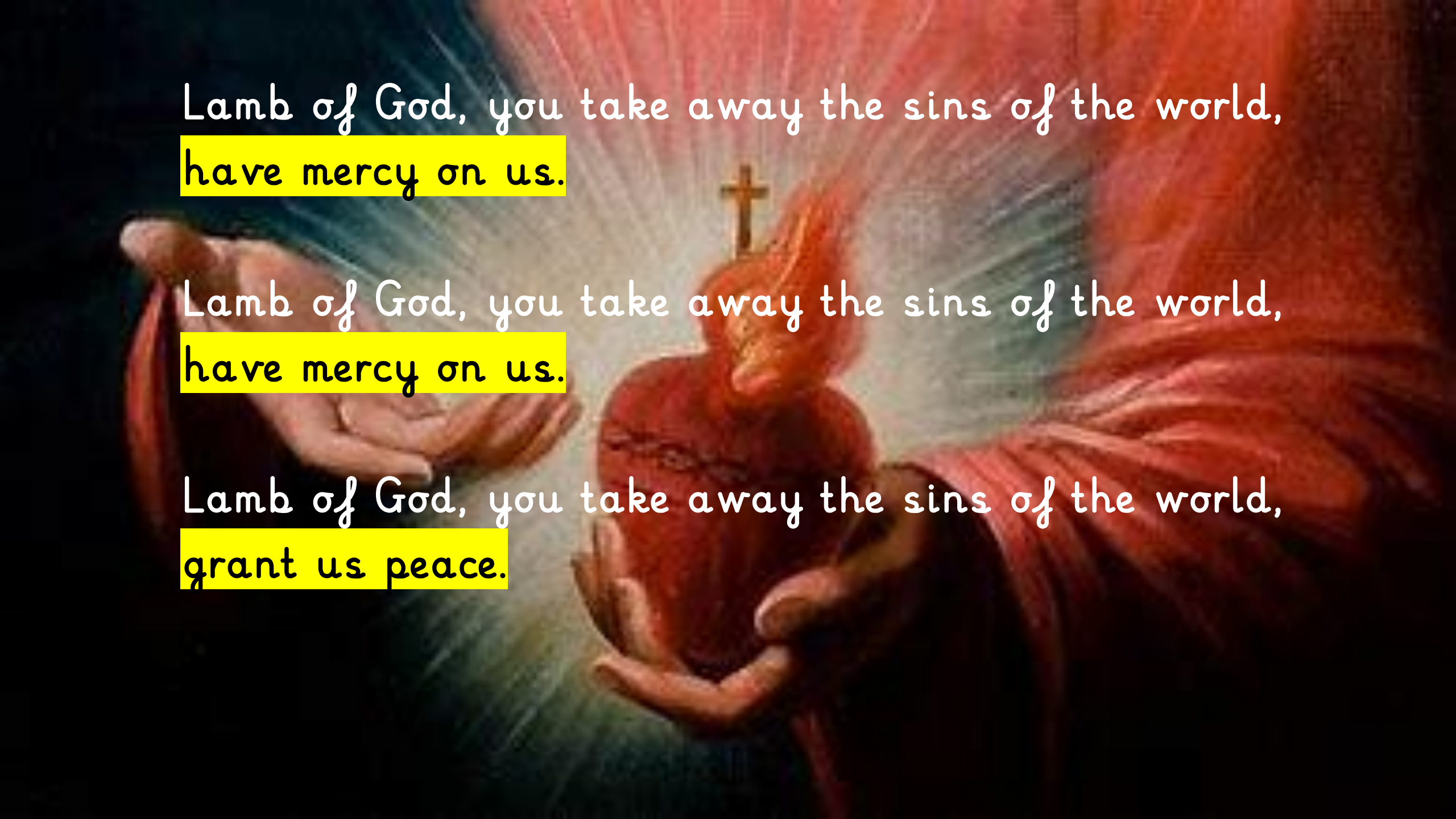

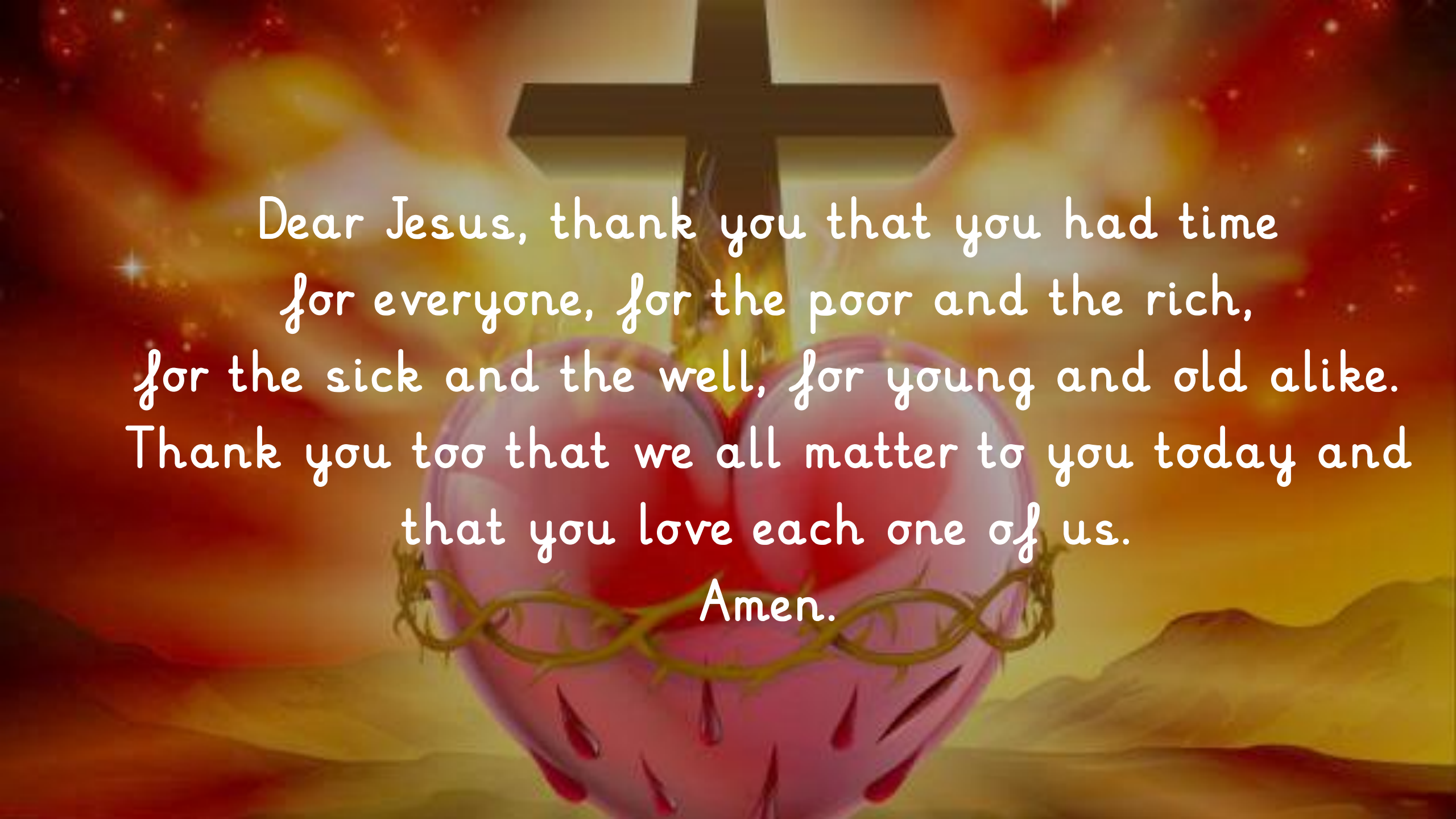

that you love each one of us.

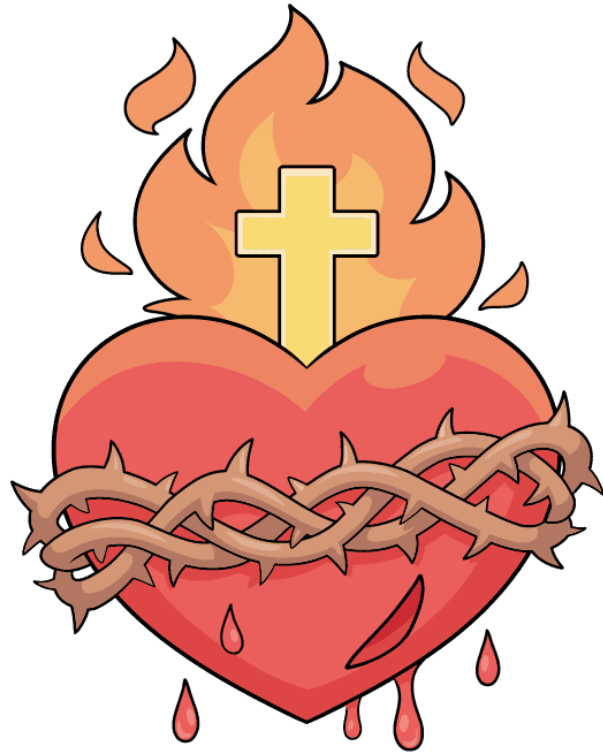

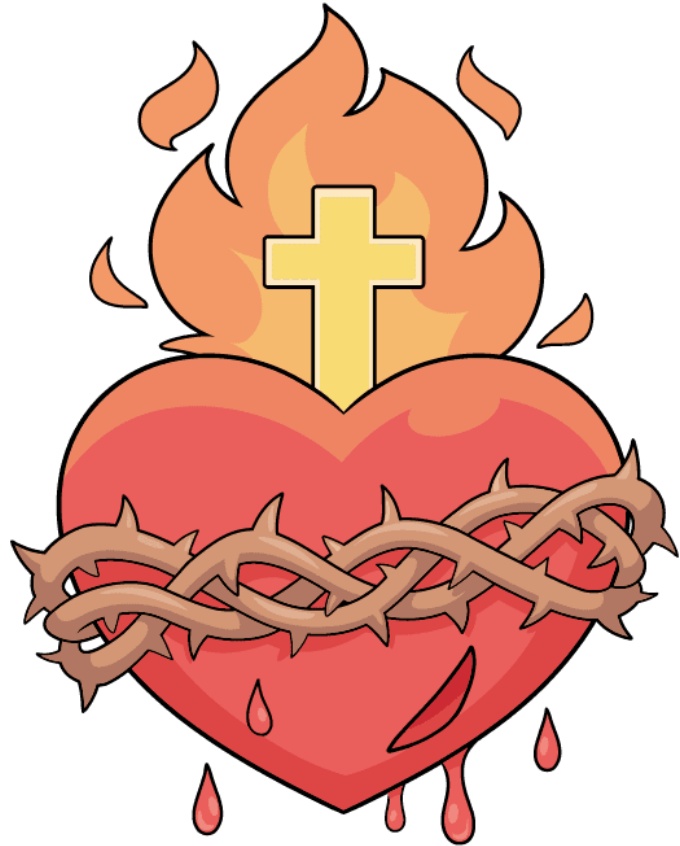

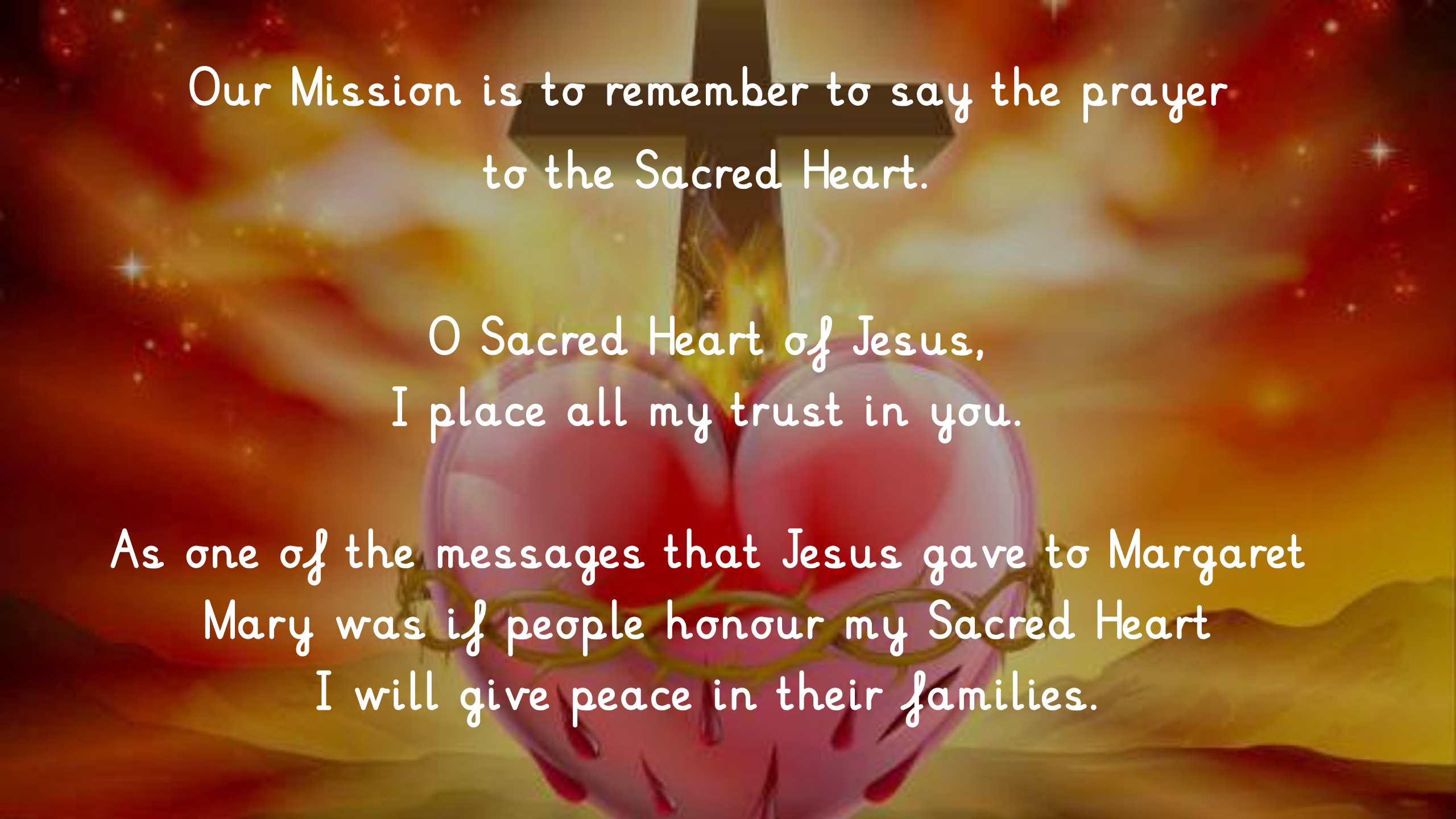
